Band Trips

Band Trips

- The last trip was to Washington D.C., it included sightseeing and concerts.
- Costs for these trips are determined by location and venues.
- A rough cost is communicated around December to allow families to plan their financial path.
- Fundraising opportunities are available.





Marching Band Camps Schedule

- Percussion Camp is the third week in July.
- Rookie Camp is the last few days of the third week in July.
- Band camp is the fourth week in July.



Student Contributions

The Gwinnett Arena

Scrip Cards

- Twice a month you can place an order for gift cards to your favorite stores.
- Order online and write a check Orange box.
(maybe pay pal soon)
- One week later your cards are handed out.
- Shop with them as you would with cash. The stores give a percentage back to the band.



Scrip Cards

Kroger gives 4% back.

You purchase \$500 Kroger Card- you pay \$500

You get a \$500 card same as cash

Your student account gets \$17

The Band gets \$3

Use for gas or groceries at any Krogers.

Gift cards earn student account \$. Neighbors, friends and relatives may also purchase cards.
